I'm trying to read a csv file... I used Split() function to store lines into array. Here the code:

```
while(!in.IsEof())
{
    Vector<Value> w;
    String line = in.GetLine();
    Vector<String> v = Split(line, ";",false);
    for(int i=0; i<v.GetCount(); i++)
        w.Add(v[i]);
    array.Add(w);
}
```

Now I have a trouble converting array column from String to double

I tryed to .SetConvert(Single<ConvDouble>()); without success

```
struct ConvDouble : Convert
{
    Value Format(const String &q) const
    {
        return q.IsNull ? Null : UPP::Format("%.2d", q);
    }
};
```

so, what's the right way to convert String to double (that allow me to use array.Get(),GetColumn() and Set() to compute) ?!

to convert from String to Double, override the function Scan.

for example:

```
struct ConvDouble : Convert
{
    Value Format(const String &q) const
    {
        return q.IsNull ? Null : UPP::Format("%.2d", q);
    }

    Value Scan(const Value& text) const
    {

        String s = text;      //
        return ScanDouble(s); // Not tested.
    }
};
```
