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This will uninstall wine 1.4 if installed and install the ppa and wine 1.5

sudo add-apt-repository ppa:ubuntu-wine/ppa sudo apt-get update sudo apt-get install wine1.5 sudo apt-get install winetricks

"if you just want fonts then in synaptic or software centre and search for ttf mscorefonts"

Getting the ttf mscorefonts may work with wine 1.4

That worked. Now I can run the U++ apps in Ububtu 64bit
