I'm almost done but I stumbled on the Xi lib which the linker says it can't find although it's present in /usr/X11R6/lib.

So I tried to compile the IDe on my Fedora computer while having previously removed the Xi lib from CtrlCore ... and the Ide compiled and linked perfectly. ==> so is this lib really needed ???
