They are already just a file Have a look at *.bm files in the directory where theide.exe is (on windows) or in your \$HOME/.upp/theide (every where else). You can just copy, rename or backup those files. On Linux, the configuration is left intact, the windows installer is perhaps bit more aggressive... If that is a problem, it should be relatively simple to adjust this behavior.
