U++ installs fine, but when I do

```
apt-get update
```

I get this warning

```

I don't see anything wrong with the instructions on the first sight...

Could you check what is in your `/etc/apt/sources.list.d/upp-nightly.list` ? There should be only one line, containing something like `/etc/apt/sources.list.d/upp-nightly.listdeb`

Also, you can check if some of the other sources files (`/etc/apt/source.list`, `/etc/apt/sources.list.d/*`) doesn't point to the same address.
