Koldo may know this one. I used TDM compiler suite but when I went to use libpq.dll (postgres) for windows I notice that the tdm libraries are static. I can't make the computer recognize -lpq. I tried putting in the windows system directory and various places but no joy.

TDM says at the command line I can use these two switches below.

-shared-libstdc++ -shared-libgcc

I tried the shared radio button versus all shared.

I don't think firebird had to link against a dll file. There libraries were named fbclient_ms.lib.

Can anyone make a cool suggestion? I am just checking out some code for db stuff with postgresql during my free time at night.
