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While I am now mostly working on improving infrastructure, there were some smaller features introduced over past weeks:

String::FindAfter is similiar to String::Find, but if found, adds the length of needle to the position, so that results points AFTER the needle found.

U++ now has plugin/POP3, contributed by Oblivion. We have also codeveloped interpretation of RFC2822 internet message format (still in progress, but generally it parses emails quite well already...)

In related news, plugin/SMTP has some new features too, most importantly it now adds Message-ID. Also, we have MIME type <-> file extension conversions and MIMEHeader parser.

To avoid confusion, String::operator+(String, int) was removed (and using it results in compilation error).
