to keep it short: If you have multiple items selected in an column list and call RemoveSelected()
then only one of the items is removed.
:roll: Unless, you call KillCursor() before!
This is because the removes are executed one by one and every remove tries to set the cursor to
a valid row; and by doing so the selection is cleared. 8o
In other development tools this would be considered as a bug, and in UPP?
A simple workaround would be that RemoveSelected calls KillCursor itself before starting to
remove.
