Hi eldiener,

If I remember correctly, the only reasonable way to build TheIDE on windows is to use TheIDE. It is little bit like the chicken/egg problem :)

You can get any of the nightly builds from here, point it to the sources you have from repository and build the package ide from uppsrc nest to get fresh TheIDE. From here on, you can always use your previous TheIDE to build a newer one after updating the repository.
