Pseudo code of function that I am looking for:

```
String DirSeparator() {  
#if defined(PLATFORM_POSIX)  
    return "/";  
#elif defined(PLATFORM_WIN32) || defined(PLATFORM_WIN64)  
    return "\\";  
#endif  
}
```
