I've used the following code for that:

```
HeaderCtrl::Style& hcs = HeaderCtrl::StyleDefault().Write();  
hcs.look[0] = Black();  
SColorLabel_Write(White());
```

And although this works, I have a problem with the last line, because now also the labels in dialogs are white and I don't want that.

Solutions?

btw, is it also possible to set the CY value/high for the headercontrols in ArrayControls?
