Hello,

If I create a DropDownList with different identifiers but the same text and different colors, the DropDownList doesn't show the new color if a different selection has already been made.

I made an example. (see attachment)

Instruction for use:

run the program and select a color combination from the DropDownList. This works ok.

then pick a different color combination. The color doesn't change, but GetData() does return the right number.

This stopped working when I updated UPP from 7746 to 8227 (Windows)

Also doesn't work with 9235 (Linux)

It was actually AttrText problem - so far, two AttrText were considered equal if text was equal. Means value displayed in DropDownList was same and no refresh was performed.
