I don't know if this information is accurate nowadays, but last time I did it, years ago, you needed to override `CtrlImg::I_O0` (normal), `CtrlImg::I_O0h` (highlighted), `CtrlImg::I_O0p` (pressed) and `CtrlImg::I_O0d` (disabled). And repeat again for variants that replace 0 with 1 and 2, for checked and for "uncertain" option.

Use something like `CtrlImg::Set(CtrlImg::I_O0, image)` to set each individual image.
