I installed other apps, java, Eclipse, etc and updated including Win7 sp1

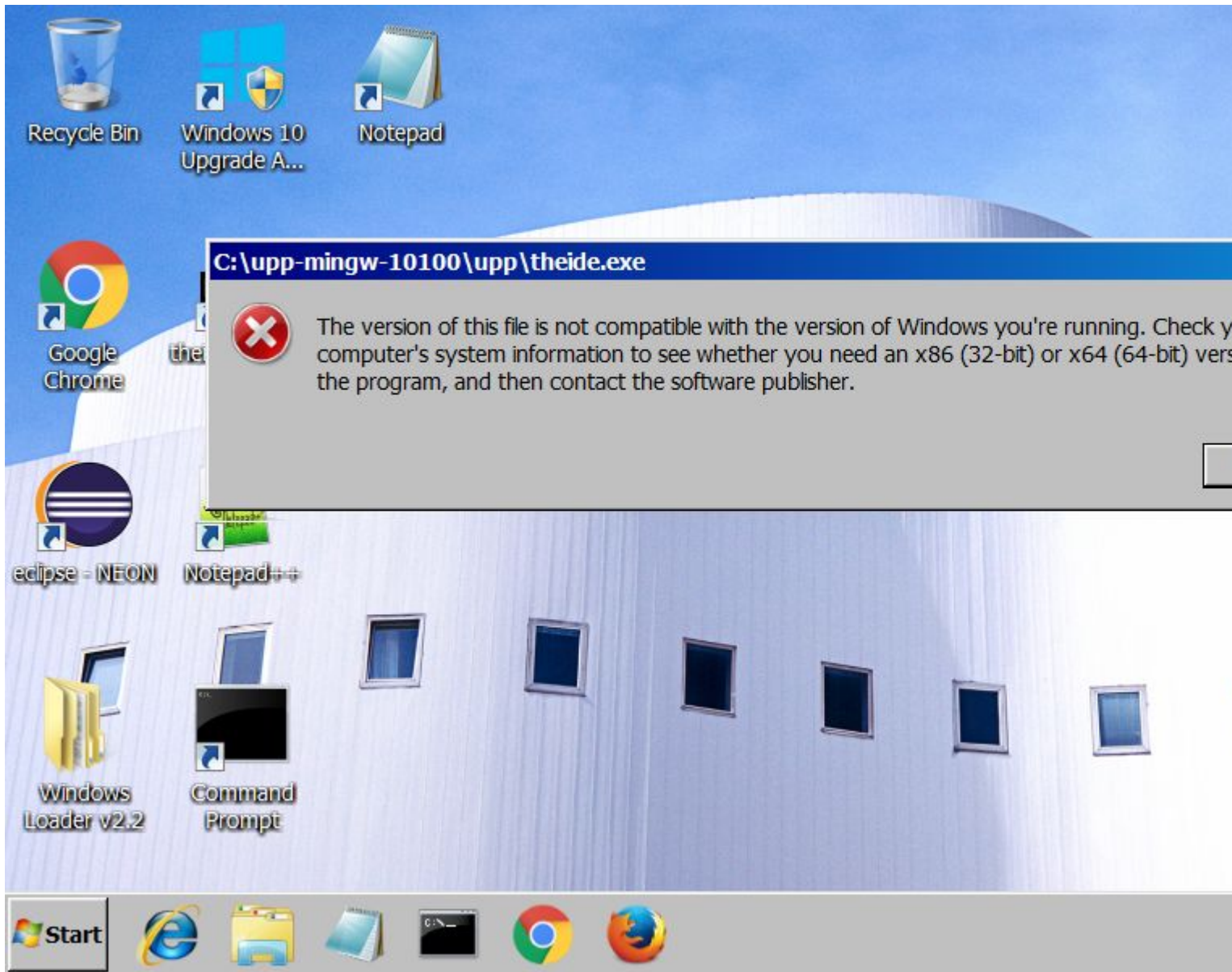
When I clicked on the link to run the ide 10100 when it first comes up I get the error 'Invalid build method (.bm).'
