However, once msMY was selected, there was a compilation error.

It turns out that Core/t.h file is missing that entry.

I fixed my local copy by adding the following line:

```
#define msMY(text) { LNGC_('M','S','M','Y', CHARSET_UTF8), text },
```

This resolved the msMY issue for me.
