It seems that gcc returns following warning: "format not a string literal and no format arguments [-Wformat-security]" when compiling plugin/tif. The solution is relatively easy. We need to replace dangerous command "TIFFError(TIFFFileName(tiff), errmsg);" by more secure "TIFFError(TIFFFileName(tiff), "%s", errmsg);". I enclose improved source file (plugin/tif/tifupp.cpp).
